RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING DISSERTATION SUBMISSION

- **Undergraduate – Facial Nerve and its clinical anatomy**
- **Postgraduate – White Matter of Cerebrum**
- **Young Faculty award* – Development of Face and its anomalies**

** Applicable to Anatomy Faculty/ Research Scholars up to the age of 35 years.*

LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION IS 7TH JULY 2019.

CONDITIONS:

1. All undergraduate and postgraduate students of Medical and Dental Colleges/Universities in Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry. The competitor for the prize for undergraduates should be an undergraduate or an Internee on the last day of submission of dissertation (i.e. 07 July 2019).
2. The Participants should become an Annual member of the Association at the time of submission of the dissertation by paying **Rs.300/**. This amount should be paid directly or by **DD FAVOURING “Treasurer, Association of Anatomists – Tamil Nadu”**.
3. The Dissertation should be sent by Registered post or by any means safe enough for transit. The last date for receipt of the Dissertation is **7TH JULY 2019**.
4. The dissertation should not exceed 30 pages of typed matter (excluding diagrams and references) for undergraduates and 50 pages of typed matter (excluding diagrams and references) for postgraduates. The typing should be double spacing in A4 sheets on one side only.
5. Every candidate must send 3 **CD's** of his/her dissertation work (**Both MS Word and PDF formats required**) and **one copy in the printed form (book) for the easy distribution to the concerned judges**.
6. A certificate to the effect that the dissertation is the bonafide work of the participant from the Head of the Department / Institution where he/she is studying/working should be enclosed separately. **IMPORTANT:** The name of the competitor, the Institute from which he/she submitting including acknowledgments should not be mentioned at any place in the main dissertation. All these should be in separate sheets. Similarly, in the CD, name and institution should not be mentioned. Name and institute must be mentioned only in the printed copy
7. The cost of preparing the dissertation should be borne by the competitor.
8. The publication of the award-winning dissertation in part or in full can be done with the prior approval of the Association.
9. A panel of three judges nominated by the Association will judge the Dissertation. The decision of the judges will be final and binding. No correspondence will be entertained from any competitor on the results announced.
10. If there is only one competitor for the prize, the judges may decide on the award of the prize or otherwise
11. A person, who has been awarded a prize earlier, is not eligible to compete.
12. Not more than two persons are allowed to jointly submit the dissertation.
